Marching Under the Stars: This is our biggest fundraiser of the fall season.

Spinatos: Spinato's is a pizza restaurant located at 16<sup>th</sup> st & Bell Rd. They open up for us one Monday a quarter and donate 20% of the nights proceeds. Next date will be posted soon.

Silent Auction: The plan this year is to try and have two, one with the Winter Concert and one with the Spring Concert.

Car Show: Dates need to be picked for this. This would be our biggest fundraiser for the spring.

Safeway is having a special now through September 4<sup>th</sup>. 10% of your purchase can go towards the band when you use your Club Card.
